

Year 1 Half term on a page: Autumn 1

In phonics lessons we will be learning...

- phase 5a sounds (ay, ou, ie, ea, oy, ir, ue, aw, wh, ph, ew, oe, au).
- phase 5b alternative pronunciations (i, o, c, g, u, ow, ie, ea, er, a, y, ch, ou).

In maths activities we will be learning to...

- represent and use number bonds and related addition facts within 10.
- read, write and interpret mathematical statements including addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs.
- add and subtract numbers to 10, including zero.
- solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations and missing number problems.

In English we will be reading...

- Pirate's Love Underpants.
- Non-fiction texts about Pirates.

In reading activities we will be learning to...

- predict what might happen in the story.
- answer questions about a story.
- explain what we think about the title, main events and characters in a story.
- participate in discussions about the stories we read.
- read High Frequency Words.
- read words with suffixes and prefixes.
- read multi-syllabic words.

In writing activities we will be learning to...

- write in a non-fiction style (e.g. labelling, lists, wanted posters, fact-files, letters).
- spell words using our phonological knowledge.
- use full stops and capital letters consistently.
- use common spelling patterns and distinguish between alternative spellings (e.g. ay and ai).
- compose and write simple sentences independently to communicate meaning.
- write using a cursive style.
- use conjunctions in our writing (and, then, but, because, so).
- use question marks and exclamation marks.

In IPC activities we will be starting our new topic **Treasure Island** and will be learning about...

- rules that pirates follow.
- roles and responsibilities pirates have on board.
- how to stay safe near water.
- pirate coins and treasure chests.
- islands that you find around the world.
- names of places that pirates travel to.
- islands that make up the UK and other locations, and the different features you see there.
- food pirates eat and where food comes from in the world.
- healthy eating and how to plan a pirate packed lunch.
- weather and climate in different places that pirates visit.
- how pirates navigate around the world.
- directions using a map and how to design our own pirate islands.
- pirate songs, dances and games.
