Dear Parents/Carers,

This is what we will be learning in Year 3 during the second half of the spring term:

Maths - statistics:

- understanding pictograms, bar charts and tables

Length and perimeter:

- measuring lengths
- converting mm to cm and m to cm (and vice versa)
- comparing, adding and subtracting lengths
- measuring and calculating perimeter

Then, revising previous learning on fractions ready for the summer term:

- recognising and finding a half, quarter and third
- understanding unit and non-unit fractions
- counting in fractions

English - 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown

In **reading** activities, we will be learning to:

- increase our familiarity with a wide range of books including fairy stories, myths and legends and retelling some of these orally
- discuss words and phrases that capture our interest and imagination
- predicting what might happen from details stated and implied
- identifying themes and conventions in a wide range of books, showing understanding through intonation, tone, volume and action
- identifying how language, structure and presentation contribute to meaning

In **writing** activities, we will be learning to:

- write for a range of purposes including story mapping, interview questions, emails, letters, notes, 'log' entries, posters and sequels
- edit writing effectively including correcting spellings and improving vocabulary
- become confident using conjunctions, prepositions and adverbs to express time, place or cause
- begin to punctuate speech accurately
- continue to include a wide range of punctuation within our writing e.g. !, ?, ' ,
