

## Year 3 Half Term on a Page: Summer Term 2023 (2)

Dear Parents/Carers.

This is what we will be learning in Year 3 during the second half of the summer term:

<u>Maths</u> - continuing with time initially: continuing to be confident telling the time to the minute (and showing this on a digital clock) then looking at start and end times and durations of time.

Shape: understanding different turns, recognising and comparing angles (right angles, acute and obtuse), understanding the difference between horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular lines, recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes.

Then statistics: collecting data and interpreting and drawing pictograms, bar charts and two-way tables.

English - 'Moon Man' by Tomi Ungerer

In **reading** activities, we will be learning to:

- · listening and responding appropriately to adults and peers
- ask relevant questions to extend vocabulary and build vocabulary and knowledge
- articulate and justify answers, arguments and opinions
- identify themes and conventions in stories
- discussing words and phrases that capture the reader's interest and imagination
- asking questions to improve understanding of a text
- drawing inferences such as characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions and justifying with evidence
- predicting what might happen from details stated and implied

In writing activities, we will be learning to:

- write for a variety of purposes including: newspaper articles, recounts, poetry, diary entries and letters
- effectively plan a narrative from scratch
- look at images in detail, discussing ideas and questions we may have about it
- continue to understand and apply a wide range of new and higher-level vocabulary including synonyms
- writing in paragraphs
- continuing to be aware and use correct punctuation including: full stops & capital letters, commas, apostrophes, inverted commas and commas after a fronted adverbial
- use editing time effectively to enhance pieces of writing
