Maths

Geometry (Shape)

- Understanding, identifying, and comparing angles
- Understanding triangles
- Understanding quadrilaterals
- Understanding Polygons
- Understanding lines of symmetry

Statistics

- Interpreting charts and making comparisons
- Interpreting and drawing line graphs

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Geometry (Position and Direction)

- Understanding and plotting coordinates
- Drawing 2-D shapes on a grid
- Understanding translation and translating shapes on a grid

English

The first week will be poetry week where children will explore, write, and publish their own poems. After, we will be starting our new book The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane by Kate DiCamillo.

Reading

- Discuss words and phrases that capture reader's interest and imagination
- Use a dictionary to check meanings of words
- Ask questions to improve understanding of the text
- Draw inferences and justify inferences with evidence from the text
- Predict what might happen from information they have deduced

Writing

- Continue to use expanded noun phrases, conjunctions, and fronted adverbials
- Write legibly and consistently
- Compose sentences using a range of sentence structures
- Think carefully about my word choices to make my writing interesting for the reader
- Use poetic devices to create poetry and song lyrics.
- Continue using literary devices (metaphors, similes, alliteration, and personification)
- Use persuasive language

Topic

Science

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• Exploring various Scientists and Inventors' work including Gerald Durell, Alexander Graham Bell, Maria Telkes, Garret Morgan, Thomas Edison and Lewis Latimer.

History

• Understanding who the Viking were and why they came to Britain, exploring Anglo-Saxon Kings and understanding Viking life, laws and justice system.

Art

• Ancient Egyptians: exploring different ways to draw faces using proportion, using charcoal to experiment with light and dark shadows and shading, then designing and making our own Egyptian masks.

Computing

 Word processing: continuing with experimenting with formatting pictures, text, tables, and layout in Microsoft Word to produce documents such as posters, letters, a rota, recipe cards and an e-voucher.
