Maths

Adding and subtraction fractions (including proper fractions, mixed number fractions and improper fractions)
Multiply a 4-digit number by a 1- or 2-digit number
Divide a 4-digit number by a 1-digit number

Solving problems involving multiplication and division
Multiply fractions by whole numbers
Calculate a fraction of an amount

Reading

- read and discuss an increasingly wide range of fiction; ^[L]_[SEP]
- reading books/texts that are structured in different ways and reading for a range of purposes;
- checking that the book makes sense to them, discussing their understanding and exploring the meaning of words

- drawing inferences such as inferring characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions, and justifying inferences with evidence;

- discuss and evaluate how authors use language considering the impact on the reader; ^[L]_[SEP]
- participate in discussions about books that are read to them and those they can read for themselves, building on their own and others' ideas and challenging views courteously

Writing

- identifying the audience for and purpose of their writing, selecting the appropriate form and using other similar writing as models for their own;
- noting and developing initial ideas, drawing on reading and research where necessary and adding detail;
- selecting appropriate grammar and vocabulary, understanding how this can change and enhance meaning;
- in narratives, describing settings, characters and atmosphere and integrating dialogue to convey character and advance the action;
- using a wide range of devices to build cohesion within and across paragraphs; using further organisational and presentational devices to structure text and to guide the reader proposing changes to vocabulary, grammar and punctuation to enhance effects and clarify meaning;
