

<u>Year 2 Half Term on a Page: Spring Term 2024 (1)</u>

Dear Parents/Carers,

This is what we will be learning in Year 2 during the first half of the spring term:

Maths - money

- Recognising coins and notes and counting money in pounds and pence
- Making and comparing amounts of money
- Finding change
- Solving problems involving money

Then, multiplication and division:

- Recognising, making and adding equal groups
- Using arrays
- Understanding how to group and share
- Learning and becoming familiar with the x2, x5 and x10 tables in addition to odd/even numbers and doubling/halving

English - in reading activities, we will be looking at poetry and incorporating all the VIPERS skills in addition to:

- Listen to, discuss and express views about a wide range of poems at a level beyond that which can be read independently
- Link what is read or heard to our own experiences
- Recognise and join in with predictable phrases in poems and recite some by heart
- Recognise simple recurring literacy language in poetry
- Continue to build up a repertoire of poems learnt by heart, appreciating these and reciting some with appropriate intonation to make the meaning clear

In writing activities, we will be looking at 'The Robot and the Bluebird' by David Lucas and learning to:

- Write for different purposes including non-chronological reports, instruction writing, letters, free verse poetry, storymaps, speech and thought bubbles and retelling a narrative from a different perspective
- Recap the four sentence types and become confident using these
- Understand and use the simple past and present tense and the past and present progressive tense
- Reread and evaluate writing to check it makes sense and make simple revisions
- Continue to punctuate writing independently and confidently with capital letters, full stops, !, ? and commas for lists
- Continue to use expanded noun phrases and a range of conjunctions within pieces of writing
- Continue to join letters in the cursive formation
