- Prepare poems to read aloud and to perform, showing understanding through intonation, tone and volume so that the meaning is clear to an audience
- Discuss and evaluate how authors use language, including figurative language, considering the impact on the reader.

In writing activities, we will continue to:

- write for a range of purposes including: poems inspired by the collection, letter writing, descriptive writing and note-taking.
- evaluate and edit writing effectively including correcting spellings and improving vocabulary
- become confident using nouns and abstract nouns, adjectives, conjunctions, prepositions and adverbs
- select appropriate grammar and vocabulary, understanding how their choices can change and enhance meaning
- continue to include a wide range of punctuation within our writing e.g. !, ?, ',
- ensure that handwriting is neat, legible and preferably joined
