- Singing counting rhymes, eg. 1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive
- Matching pictures and objects
- Sorting objects in different ways and explaining my reasoning
- Compare amounts using language such as more and fewer
- Learn to measure sizes, mass and capacity
- Learn to copy and continue simple patterns
- Learn to create simple patterns

- Ask questions to get to know my friends in my new class
- Talk about my family
