



## Maths - Multiplication and Division and Fractions

Know what factors and multiples are; find and learn the prime numbers, square numbers and cube numbers, multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000; multiply and divide by multiples of 10, 100 and 1000; find equivalent fractions (unit and non-unit); covert between improper and mixed number fractions; compare and order fractions; add and subtract fractions.

## PE- Swimming and Hockey

Children will develop the skills of both sports and gain an understanding about the rules and skills.

## RE

Continue to look into the question - Who should care for our world - What are the ways communities care? We will learn how different groups holding different religious and non-religious views care for the local and world environment. They will also learn why people think they have a duty to preserve the planet.

## Spanish

Children will learn vocabulary for sports & revision of opinions; revise clothes and 'lleva' (I wear); learn the word 'para' (for) and use it in context; know how to conjugate the verb tener (to have); revising the adjectival agreement rule and apply it to writing; learn the Spanish Christmas Carol.

## Reading

### Text: The Highwayman

Develop VIPERS reading skills through a wide variety of texts: fiction, non-fiction & poetry; explain and discuss understanding of what has been read; predict what might come next based on what they have read; identify and discuss themes and conventions; discuss understanding and explore meaning of words in context; ask questions to improve understanding; draw inferences about characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions and justifying inferences with evidence.

## Science - Living things and their Habitats

Children will learn about the reproduction of plants and animals. They will learn about the life cycle of mammals looking into the life cycle of Kangaroos. They will learn about the work of scientist Jane Goodall. They will discover the process of metamorphosis and compare life cycles of different animal groups.

## History - Leisure and Tourism

The children will look into changes in holidays across the 20<sup>th</sup> Century. They will find out about access to sport and the impact of music on people's lives in the 20<sup>th</sup> century. They will find out about the 'Golden Age' of the cinema and how television changed people lives. They will also find out about the rise of technology.

## Art- Wildlife Birds

The children will be sketching feathers and birds looking closely at textures and details using observational drawing skills. They will use printing to create and clay to create artwork on tiles. The children will create sculptures of birds. They will learn to evaluate their work and the work of others.

## Writing

**Spellings:** Homophones & near homophones; words with silent letters; modal verbs; words ending in -ment.  
**Punctuation:** Using commas after fronted adverbials and for lists, using apostrophes for contractions, speech punctuation.  
**Grammar:** Expanded noun phrases, adverbs, different conjunctions used to link ideas; organising ideas into paragraphs, past and present progressive tense, cohesive devices, modal verbs.

## Music - Drumming

Children will be playing the Djembe drums to accompany African songs. They will be learning to read and play rhythm notation.

## PSHE

We will be looking into race and racism; the human body; how caffeine can be helpful and harmful and the power of our words.
