



Maths - Multiplication and Division and Fractions

Add and subtract fractions; multiply up to 4-digit number by a 2-digit number using written method; use short division to divide 4-digit numbers by a 1-digit number; divide with remainders; solve problems involving multiplication and division; multiply fractions by integers; calculate fractions of an amount; use fractions as operators.

PE- Gymnastics and Netball

Children will develop the skills of both sports and gain an understanding about the rules and skills.

RE

Look into the question - Why do people judge?

They will look into how people are discriminated against, why people are judged or labelled before someone gets to know them (particularly due to their faith), and the significance of the holocaust memorial day.

Spanish

Children will revise animal names and learn new animals in Spanish, learn how to use a bilingual Spanish-English dictionary, read and practise reciting an authentic Spanish poem, listen and respond to a Spanish story and write own version of a story using memorisation aids.

Reading

Text: Skellig

Develop VIPERS reading skills through a wide variety of texts: fiction, non-fiction & poetry; explain and discuss understanding of what has been read; predict what might come next based on what they have read; identify and discuss themes and conventions; discuss understanding and explore meaning of words in context; ask questions to improve understanding; draw inferences about characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions and justifying inferences with evidence.

Science - Properties and Changes of Materials

In this unit, the children will classify materials using their properties and test for thermal and electrical insulators and conductors. They will look into materials that dissolve and whether materials are magnetic or not. Finally, they will investigate reversible and irreversible changes.

Geography - Marvellous Maps

The children will learn how to use an atlas. They will learn how to read different maps by learning the symbols used in Ordnance Survey maps. When using maps, children will look at using compass directions and grid references. They will also plan their own routes.

DT - Marbulous Structures

The children will be looking at marble runs and how they work. They will be testing their own bridges and developing their joining and bending skills. After learning the skills, the children will then collaboratively make their own marble runs and evaluate each other's work.

Writing

Spellings: Statutory Year 5 and 6 spelling words, Suffixes -ity, -ness and -ship to create nouns and continue to look at homophones and near homophones.

Punctuation: Using commas around relative clauses, before fronted adverbials and in lists. Use brackets, dashes and commas for parenthesis and use apostrophes for possession.

Grammar: Look at prepositions, coordinating and subordinating conjunctions and continue to think about word choice and description when writing.

Music - Drumming

Children will be playing the Djembe drums to accompany African songs. They will be learning to read and play rhythm notation.

Computing- Radio Station

In this unit, the children will learn how to use Audacity. They will make their own jingles, podcasts and adverts.

PSHE

We will be looking into race and racism; the power of words; social media and responsibility and inspiration.
