



## Maths - Fractions, Decimals and Percentages

Calculate fractions of an amount; use fractions as operators; understand equivalent fractions and decimals; order and compare decimals; round decimals to the nearest whole number and tenth; understand percentages; write equivalent fractions, decimals and percentages; find the perimeter and area of rectangles, polygons and compound shapes.

## PE- Dance and Various Team Sports

Children will develop the skills of both sports and gain an understanding about the rules and skills. They will also work on their competitive and team skills.

## RE

Continue to look at the question - Why do people judge? They will look into how we can be bridge builders between people, How have campaigners made a difference. We will also understand how Christians celebrate Easter.

## Spanish

Learn how to describe the weather. Be able to give a simple weather forecast. Remember which countries have Spanish as their main language. Read and understand the traditional story : El Viento y El Sol (The Wind and the Sun). Learn about how Easter is celebrated in Spanish speaking countries.

## Reading

### Text: The Adventures of Odysseus

Develop VIPERS reading skills through a wide variety of texts: fiction, non-fiction & poetry; explain and discuss understanding of what has been read; predict what might come next based on what they have read; identify and discuss themes and conventions; discuss understanding and explore meaning of words in context; ask questions to improve understanding; draw inferences about characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions and justifying inferences with evidence.

## Science - Forces

In this unit, the children will investigate the effect of air and water resistance as well as friction. They will understand that objects fall towards earth because of gravity. As well as this, they will look into forces acting on levers, pulleys and gears.

## History - Ancient Greece

The children will learn about what life was like in Ancient Greece. They will learn about Alexander the Great and his impact on Ancient Greece. They will look at the difference between Sparta and Athens. They will also learn about the Olympic games and compare it to the Olympic games now. We will also find out about Greek gods and the Trojan War.

## Art - European Art and Artists

We will find out about Anselm Kiefer, Michelangelo, Le Corbusier, Rembrandt, Coco Chanel and Salvador Dali. They will be sketching, painting, drawing portraits and making hats.

## PSHE

We will be looking into race and racism, British values: Laws and Parliament, and British values: Freedom of speech and movement.

## Writing

**Spellings:** Continue to look at homophones and near homophones, spell words with the 'or' sound spelt 'or' and 'au', convert nouns into verbs using the suffixes: -ate, -ise, -ify, -en.

**Punctuation:** Using brackets for parenthesis, using commas to clarify meaning and look at direct and indirect speech.

**Grammar:** Use subordinating and coordinating conjunctions and determiners.

## Music - Drumming

Children will be playing the Djembe drums to accompany African songs. They will be learning to read and play rhythm notation.
